OUR HISTORY IN MARTIN COUNTY

In 1991, our Board of Directors voted to expand the Community Foundation's service area to include Martin County, an area that mirrored Palm Beach County in terms of great wealth — and great need. That same year, we changed our name from the Palm Beach County Community Foundation to the Community Foundation for Palm Beach and Martin Counties to affirm our commitment.
